Missions

We praise the Lord for the ministry of Hope Biblical theological Seminary of Cap-Haitian. 20 of our students will graduate with their bachelor degree on June 1st. Many of the young men who graduated from our Bible College are now in full time pastoral ministry. Our plan is to train as many students as possible and to plant Bible-believing and Bible-teaching churches all over Haiti. There are lots of churches in Haiti, but very few of them preach the truth of the Word of God. That is why we would like to buy a piece of land and build a campus for the College. Many students do not attend our College because we do not have a place for them to stay. We found a good piece of land, it will cost us \$80,000 U.S. We are required to give a deposit of \$40,000, and we have only \$10,000 available. Please pray for the needed funds.
