## Local Missions

### Matthew House Windsor



Matthew House seeks to provide comfort and security for newly arrived refugee claimants in Windsor by providing transitional housing and settlement assistance.

A Refugee is...one who has a “well-founded fear of being persecuted for reasons of race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion” and is afraid to remain in his or her country of origin. As a refugee claimant they have fled their homeland and upon arrival in Canada ask for asylum. They have no sponsors to assist them.

...a person like you or I who has much to contribute to Canadian Society. They are doctors, lawyers, accountants, business people, pastors, engineers and farmers from all over the world.

# International Missions

## Haiti

### The Biblical Theological Seminary of Hope in Cap-Haïtien (STBEC)

This program is aimed at leaders of Christian churches who want to deepen their biblical and theological knowledge to be better equipped for ministry.

Many of the young men who graduated from our Bible College are now in full time pastoral ministry. Our plan is to train as many students as possible and to plant Bible-believing and Bible-teaching churches all over Haiti. There are lots of churches in Haiti, but very few of them preach the truth of the Word of God.



### Togo Africa – The Weston Family

It's hard to believe that the Weston family has been in Togo for almost 2 years now. They will be returning to Canada in a few short months. Nate has continued working in construction during this last term.



To say good medical care is scarce in West Africa is an understatement. For every 100,000 people in Togo, there are only 4 doctors, compared with 256 doctors in the United States. As a result, most people rely on witch doctors or tribal doctors to attend their medical needs — often causing more harm than good.

Spiritually, their situation is even more dire. Part of Togo is located in a region of the world characterized by its great poverty, poor quality-of-life, and little to no access to Christian resources. Nearly 80% of northern Togo is Muslim, and approximately one-in-three Togolese practice some form of animism.

To help meet the incredible physical and spiritual need, ABWE built the Hospital of Hope, and since its opening in February 2015 it has already shared the gospel with 11,500 patients and helped our missionaries start more than 12 Bible studies and home groups in surrounding villages. People have come to Jesus, and a number of local churches have been started.

We want to provide safe clean drinking water to those who do not have it. We have implemented 2 filter production locations in Maisi Cuba. We are using the BioSand Filter which filters out almost all bacteria and viruses and provides 70 liters of safe clean drinking water per day. These filters are placed in homes free of charge. Once placed, they share with their neighbors as the need is great.

### Alicia Oakley - Malawi Africa Healthcare



Shortly after being saved in 2010, God spoke to my heart that He wanted me to become a nurse and serve in Africa. After graduating from nursing school in 2013 I became a member of SIM serving in Lilongwe, Malawi at Partners in Hope as a ward nurse caring for those who are HIV positive and are suffering from other illnesses.

My ministry is not only with the patients I serve, but also to my coworkers. I hope to continue to build meaningful relationships with them and continue to be a light for Christ at Partners in Hope and in Malawi.



### Canadian Baptist Ministries Project - Casa de la Amistad

Casa works with vulnerable children whose parents live in prison. Most come with heartbreaking stories of abuse or violation and negative family structure. We're making a difference in their lives, showing God's love. These children go to Casa de la Amistad for meals, tutoring support, counselling and a safe place to play. Pray that their children would also feel safe, secure and loved. May God answer their prayers and provide for their every need – both physically and spiritually.

### Samaritan's Purse – Rohingya Refugees

Almost one million impoverished Rohingya people have fled violence in Myanmar and are now living in temporary huts and under tarps in refugee camps in Bangladesh. More than half of those are children. Samaritan's Purse is working to provide food, tarps, and non-food items and an opportunity for Rohingya families to experience God's love. They are also working with Memorial Christian Hospital to provide medical equipment and supplies.
