It is with thankful hearts, that we are able to share this report from our Mission trip in March. We are sorry it has taken this long to have something written up, but no sooner did we arrive back home, we had to leave due to a family emergency. Life happens. We rejoice with the news that we were able to bring \$17,000 USD to go towards the debt on the house that we committed to purchasing. The remaining debt is \$21,000 USD. We want to thank each and every person who has contributed with donations and with prayer. We are grateful for the support that has been given. The two families are in the house. Some good news is that the daughter is doing better in this location. The pastors are ministering in their local community. They have started bible studies and have seen God work in many lives. All the while taking care of Eriennis. This trip Johan and Sarah Unger came along. Sarah witnessed the handing over of funds, as she is a signing authority on the mission account. Because the Unger's came with us, we were able to bring with us no less than 680 lbs-308 kgs of supplies. Breaking it down that is 8 - 70lbs bags as well as our carry-ons weighing no less than 30 lbs each. Along with being able to pay for almost half of what we owe on the house, we were able to bless 5 churches, Teen Challenge, 3 families and more. We can't wait to be able to tell you all about it. We are planning our next trip in November. Would you like to come along? We have no words to express how awesome it is to see God work. It brings these words from this old hymn to mind:

*He leadeth me, He leadeth me, By His own hand He leadeth me;
His faithful foll'wer I would be, For by His hand He leadeth me.*
